It is important that you follow all instructions provided in the application packet. The Foundation Scholarship Review Committee will not be able to accept or consider any incomplete or late submissions.

Scholarship recipients will receive notification via mail by **May 22, 2010** and will have their names listed in the 2010 Lakeside High School Graduation Ceremony program.

Specifics to the Application Forms:

The PDF forms are designed to be completed and saved with Adobe Reader. It is important to use Reader to create a document which is fill-able, save-able and return-able. The link to download the newest version of Adobe Reader is [here](#).

Once you have the correct program, save as/download the form to your desktop; open the Reader application and then open the document with the 'Open' command under the 'File' dropdown. After you have completed the form, 'save as' to your desktop or other folder using your last name, first name, create an email and attach the saved PDF. 1. **Applicant Information Form.** (save, fill-in, save and send to LHSFScholarship@gmail.com)
2. **LHS Official Transcript Release Form.** (fill-in name, print form, sign and deliver to Ms. Casey)
3. **Resume** (sample provided) detailing community service involvement, school clubs & organizations, leadership positions, awards and other recognitions. (save as a document, and send to LHSFScholarship@gmail.com)
4. **Essay** describing how your community service involvement and academic pursuits have shaped your high school experience. Include information on your plans for higher education and career goals. This essay should be 750-1,000 words, 12pt, double-spaced. (save as a document and send to LHSFScholarship@gmail.com)
5. **Two letters of recommendation**, one from an individual with specific knowledge of the applicant's exemplary community service, and one from a Lakeside High School staff or faculty member. **The letters are to be electronically submitted direct to the Scholarship Review Committee at the email address noted above, they should not be sent via the student. The letters should address the following:**
 - a. Outstanding service to school and community.
 - b. Academic accomplishments
 - c. A demonstrated willingness to assume leadership positions.

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Scholarship Recipient's responsibilities:

1. Recipient is able to provide a copy of the Letter of Acceptance from an accredited college, university, or other institution of formal training.
2. Recipients may receive other scholarships for the time covered by this scholarship. However, should the recipient receive a full scholarship he/she must notify the Lakeside High School Foundation and relinquish this scholarship.
3. In the event the recipient decides not to pursue a post secondary school, the Lakeside High School Foundation must be notified, and the recipient will be required to relinquish this scholarship.
