2010 Scholarship Application

The Lakeside High School Foundation, Inc. is proud to sponsor the **Viking Athletics Scholarship**. Funds for this scholarship are maintained by the Foundation and have been made possible by the generosity of our donors.

This scholarship is open to all Lakeside High School seniors who have received the **Viking Award** recognition for their sport during their senior year and have demonstrated overall academic excellence. Eligible applicants intend to enroll in an accredited college, university, or other institution of formal education in Fall 2010 and have maintained a minimum 3.0 GPA, unweighted on a 4.0 scale.

All completed application packets must be received by **May 14, 2010**. To ensure no athlete is excluded from participation, exception will be made for spring sports if the sport and Viking Award designation has not occurred prior to the above listed date. The varsity coaches will work direct with the Lakeside High School Foundation Review Committee to determine a deadline for their spring sport athlete.

Applications are received and reviewed by a scholarship panel comprised of, but not limited to, members of the Lakeside High School Foundation Board of Directors. It is important that you follow all instructions provided in the attached application packet. The Foundation Scholarship Review Committee will not be able to accept or consider any incomplete or late submissions.

Scholarship recipients will receive notification in **June 2010** and will have their names listed on the Foundation website and scheduled newsletter.

Specifics to the Application Forms:

The PDF forms are designed to be completed and saved with Adobe Reader. It is important to use Reader to create a document which is fill-able, save-able and return-able. The link to download the newest version of Adobe Reader is [here](http://get.adobe.com/reader/). <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>

Once you have the correct program, save as/download the form to your desktop; open the Reader application and then open the document with the 'Open' command under the 'File' dropdown. After you have completed the form, 'save as' to your desktop or other folder using your last name, first name, create an email and attach the saved PDF. Please submit the following:

1. **Applicant Information Form** (save, fill-in, save and send to LHSFScholarship@gmail.com)
2. **LHS Official Transcript Release Form.** (fill-in name, print form, sign and deliver to Ms. Casey)
3. **Resume** (sample attached) detailing involvement within their sport, school clubs & organizations, community service, leadership positions, awards and other recognitions. (save as a document, and send to LHSFScholarship@gmail.com)
4. **Essay** describing how your involvement with sports and academic pursuits have shaped your high school experience. Include information on your plans for higher education and career goals. This essay should be 750-1,000 words, 12pt, double-spaced. (save as a document and send to LHSFScholarship@gmail.com)
5. **Two letters of recommendation**, one from an individual with specific knowledge of the applicant's exemplary efforts in their sport, and one from a Lakeside High School staff or faculty member. **The letters are to be electronically submitted direct to the Scholarship Review Committee at LHSFScholarship@gmail.com, they should not be sent via the student. The letters should address the following:**
 - a. Outstanding service to school and highlights why this student received the Viking Award;
 - b. Academic accomplishments;
 - c. A demonstrated willingness to assume leadership positions.
